The **LoyalFree app** is available to all levy payers to use as a promotional tool for your business. With over 120,000 users nationwide, businesses can add offers and loyalty schemes to the platform for users to take advantage of whilst shopping locally. Defibrillator

The BID continues to fund the maintenance of the **Defibrillator** which we installed on the Castle and Falcon pub in 2020, due to the future demolition of the pub this Defibrillator is currently

at the White Horse pub and will be installed on the outside of the building in a lockable cabinet. The unit provides much needed lifesaving equipment in the BID area. This is in a lockable cabinet and the code can be obtained by calling 999.



Derbyshire Business Crime Reduction Partnership (DBCPRP)

St Peters Quarter and Cathedral Quarter BID's continue to collaborate with the Chamber of Commerce to bring the Derbyshire Business Crime Reduction Partnership (DBCPRP) to the city, providing levy-paying businesses with access to the county-wide scheme free of charge. Users can download the DISC app which gives them the ability to share intel, report incidents to the Police, view offender photo galleries, and receive crime alerts and newsletters.

We also hold monthly meetings in person with representatives from the scheme, the police and PPO's which users are welcome to attend and give their feedback.

Purple Flag Accreditation



St Peters Quarter have played an integral part supporting Derby City Council over the last 10 years in the process to retain the **Purple Flag Accreditation**. The status recognises excellence in managing the evening and night time economy in a town or city.

Bleed Kits

The BID has been working closely with Derby City Council and Cathedral Quarter BID to install more **Bleed Kits** which provide vital support when a serious incident takes place. In St Peters Quarter there is already one installed at NatWest and soon to be one installed on the White Horse pub. This is in a lockable cabinet and the code can be obtained by calling 999.

Tidy Days

The BID now hosts monthly tidy sessions to bring the business community together to help keep the BID area clean. These sessions are supported by the Street Pride Team who provide us with much needed equipment, PPOs, Police and PCSOs. In one session alone 40 needles were removed from car parks and alleyways in the BID area. Also a huge thank you to McDonald's, Costa and Carnero Lounge for providing much needed refreshments after the event.



Storewatch radio loan scheme

We continue to provide the **Storewatch Radio loan scheme** to help businesses share information and make the area safer. They enable businesses to keep in contact with one another, the Rangers and other partners, such as CCTV and the Police.



Floral displays

The BID has again funded the installation and maintenance of hanging baskets and floral planters around the BID area this summer, creating a brighter and more pleasant environment for workers and visitors to St Peters Quarter. The displays will be in place from mid June, through to October.



Great British Spring Clean

In March, the BID supported the Keep Britain Tidy initiative – The Great British Spring Clean. Joined by volunteers from a number of local businesses we collected over 20 bags of litter from around the BID area. Derby City Council's Streetpride team also performed a number of tasks in support with gum removal, jet washing and cleaning the windows of vacant properties.

ARG – Vacant units

Using Additional Restrictions Grant (ARG) funding, and working with Carla Dee a local artist, the BID has continued to increase the vibrancy of the area through more artwork installations on vacant units.

The poetry trail is still live on the Loyal Free app showing the locations of different poetry verses on occupied units. The poetry verses have all been written by James McInerney as part of the poetry project which had been created to send positive messages out to people.



SPQ Annual Report

The 2022/23 St Peters Quarter Annual Report was posted out to businesses along with levy bills in April as well as being available to view on the SPQ website. The report featured a review of the work carried out by the BID during 2022/23, a financial summary and information on how you can get involved in your BID, thereby maximising the value for money you receive for your BID levy.

King's Coronation Trail

To celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III, we created a poster trail for families to follow during the period of 2nd – 14th May. 10 posters were displayed in business windows, and each contained a different letter and fun fact about the King. Using the LoyalFree app to locate the posters, participants then were challenged to unscramble the letters they had found to reveal the word 'Coronation'.



Footfall cameras

The BID continues to fund footfall cameras in the BID area to enable us to gather crucial data regarding the number of visitors to the area which can then be used to aid the attraction of new businesses and investment to the St Peters Quarter.



Retail Sales Monitor

Partnerships for Better Business (pbb uk), the managing agents for St Peters Quarter and Cathedral Quarter BIDs, have continued to operate a weekly sales and footfall monitor scheme covering both BID areas. This data has been crucial in helping to monitor the performance of the city during periods of restrictions and will assist decision-making during the recovery and transformation of the city.



Developments in and around St Peters Quarter



Derby Market Hall

The refurbishment of **Derby Market Hall** has commenced its second phase of work, making major internal and external improvements. The Market Hall is set to become a vibrant retail and leisure destination, linking Derbion and St Peters Quarter to the Cathedral Quarter and Becketwell. When complete, it will pay homage to its heritage while evolving to meet modern needs and consumer demand. The Market Hall is expected to reopen in late 2024.

Becketwell

The construction of the 259 Build to Rent (BTR) apartment block known as 'The Condor' (managed by Grainger) is near completion and expected to open before the summer. The apartments benefit from a roof terrace, 24 hour gym and free wifi.

The **Becketwell** arena is expected to host over 200 cultural and commercial events each year and attract an additional 250,000 visitors to the city, construction will commence shortly, with completion expected in late 2024.



Becketwell Welcome Packs

The BID is working closely with Grainger to deliver welcome packs for the new tenants coming into the area. The Welcome packs will contain deals and offers from the local businesses within St Peters Quarter working as a way for businesses to showcase and introduce themselves to the new tenants. Eastern Gateway/Eagle Quarter

Derbion have submitted plans to Derby City Council which will transform the current site of the Eagle Market if approved. Phase one of the **Eagle Quarter** development is already being considered within the proposed **Eastern Gateway** project on part of the existing Eagle Market site.

The masterplan includes new homes and commercial uses with new public spaces and walkable streets that will integrate the site with the rest of the City Centre and improve new connections to the river.
